## Always prepared

Risk management is a core component of Thales Australia's operations in Mulwala. Thales abides by the Department of Defence principles for the storage of ammunition and explosives, covering manufacture, storage, research and development, breakdown and disposal, test and trials, and laboratory work. Through strict compliance with these comprehensive guidelines we ensure the Mulwala site meets global best practice, helping ensure that surrounding communities, Thales employees and public and private assets are subjected to minimal risk. We can't eliminate that risk completely, so in the extremely unlikely event that an on-site emergency does occur, it is essential that residents in the local community know what to do and what the impact could be.

# Did you know?

The chances of an incident happening at this site are extremely low and no action is likely to ever be needed. We care about your safety and have inserted an emergency response card for you to keep. The procedures 'What to do in an emergency' are not new but act as an additional community safe guard, Thales Australia is required to draw them to your attention.
